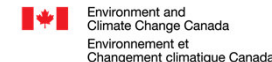
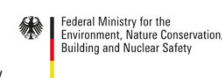

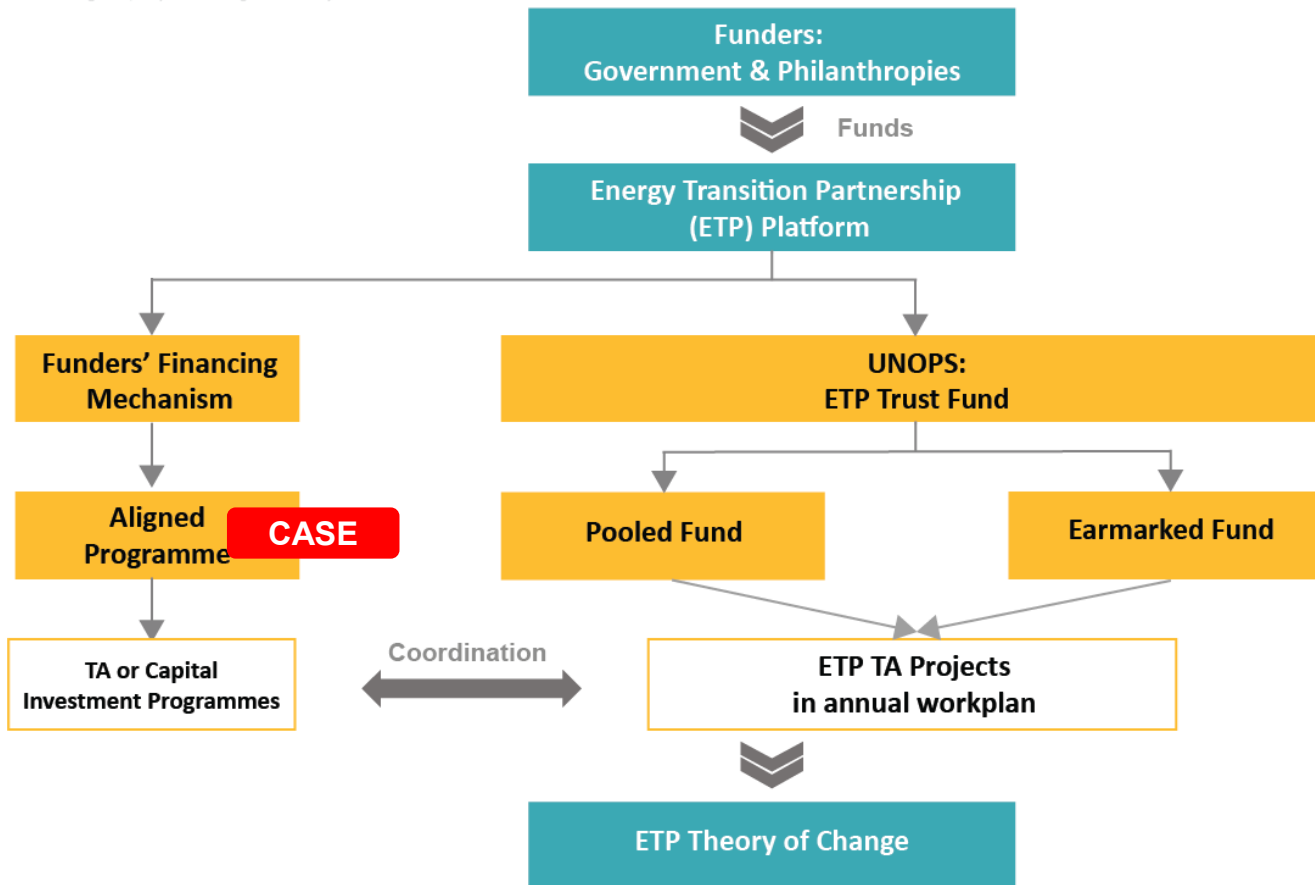

## Energy Transition Partnership: Programming and coordination flow

ETP secretariat responsible for development and implementation of ETP PA projects and for coordination of these projects with aligned programmes.

### UNOPS-ETP Technical Assistant Projects

Projects financed through pooled/earmarked funds and identified in Annual workplans

TA projects sourced from: Call for proposal

Intelligence work: gaps identification, coordination with ongoing initiatives, aligned programmes etc.  
Implementation: identification of delivery partners (competitively - following UNOPS grant process)

**CASE**

Technical assistance or capital investment programmes aligned to ETP theory of change but funded by ETP funders through their own mechanism. Coordination at governance and operational level with ETP
