Behaviour

- All participants should refrain from any offensive, threatening, discriminatory or harassing verbal expression or behaviour. Any such verbal expression or behaviour, including but not limited to in relation to race, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability or age, is absolutely prohibited. Harassment includes, but is not limited to, any use of abusive or degrading language, intimidation, stalking, harassing photography or recording, inappropriate physical contact or unwelcome sexual attention.
- EMA reserves the right in its sole discretion to refuse entry or admission to SIEW 2023 to any person or to remove or prohibit any person from attending or participating in SIEW 2023, including but not limited to any person who behaves in an inappropriate, disorderly, disrespectful or dangerous manner or who fails to comply with the SIEW 2023 Code of Conduct, without any refund of ticket price paid.
